APOS Wildlife Management Scholarship

This scholarship is being offered to post-secondary students enrolled in wildlife biology and management, wildlife conservation enforcement, or related studies. This scholarship is a fitting testament to the mission of the Alberta Professional Outfitters Society and maintaining a healthy wildlife population. This scholarship is intended to support the dreams and goals of those who are passionate about wildlife conservation and appreciative of the role placed by hunters and outfitters.

Amount: up to \$1,000 CDN

Number of Awards: There will be up to 5 awards granted annually.

Field of Study: Wildlife Technician, Wildlife Biology and Management, Wildlife Conservation Enforcement, Biological Sciences, Environmental Studies

Eligibility: Available to full-time students who have completed at least one semester in a program offered by an accredited Alberta Post-Secondary Educational Institute. Preference will be given to students from rural Alberta communities.

Application Instructions: All applicants must complete the application form.

Application Deadline: Applications can be sent in anytime and are reviewed before September.
